- 2. An adjective relating to, or the area near, the ulna. (5)
- 3. A fold of skin covering the tip of the clitoris or penis. (7)
- 6. One of usually two organs that produce ova and secrete estrogen and progesterone. (5)
- 8. The front part of the human leg between the knee and the ankle. (4)
- 11. Of or involving the rectum. (6)
- 14. Of or pertaining to the pair of endocrine glands near the kidney. (7)
- 15. The lower jawbone; it's hinged to open the mouth. (8)
- 16. It's at the end of

- 2. It's the upper element of the hinged bones that open the mouth. (5,7)
- 4. The part of the skull that encloses the brain. (7)
- 5. The underside of the foot. (4)
- 7. A nerve cell in the brain. (5,4)
- 9. It's a finger or toe. (5)
- 10. A small opening in the skin. (4)
- 11. Of or relating to the kidneys. (5)
- 12. The outer and thinner of the two bones of the human leg between the knee and ankle. (4,4)

- 13. The inner and thicker of the two bones of the human leg between the knee and ankle. (5)
- 19. It is hinged so you can open your mouth. (7)
- 20. A hollow muscular organ in the pelvic cavity of females. (4)
- 23. Technically, the part of the superior limb between the shoulder and the elbow but commonly used to refer to the whole superior limb. (3)
- 25. Fleishy folds of tissue as those surrounding the mouth. (3)
